#### **School Accountability Report Card (SARC)**

- There was discussion about class sizes. Concern with 2nd and 4th grade class sizes was voiced. Mrs. Oliveros asked what additional support her children are receiving since they are in those 2 classes. 2nd grade has paras to support. 4th grade felt additional support wasn't needed.
- Concern was brought up about the lack of supervision of SPED students during recess. Mrs. Hansen said she would look into this.
