Brittanee explained the difference between STAR and SRI to the committee. She stated that SRI focused on vocabulary, whereas STAR focuses on the parts of reading comprehension. Provides the teacher with more details about students' level of reading comprehension. A discussion was brought up regarding that we didn't have the incentive part completed, and students and parents are confused and feeling frustrated. Laura shared that grade levels are working together to come up with incentive goals and will have them in place by the middle of October. Teachers are encouraging students to take quizzes.
