AGENDA/MINUTES (Maria Silva and Laura Hansen)

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 9:07 am.**
- 2. Agenda -** Yadira Saavedra approved the agenda, and Fabian Ayala seconded the motion.
- 3. Celebration for students who are being reclassified**
 - a. Mrs. Hansen discussed that students were being recognized today for being reclassified, and then the PJUSD Board will also celebrate and provide certificates to students during the April Board meeting.
 - b. 16 students were recognized
 - c. Juice and Donuts were provided
- 4. English Learner Class Percentage -**
 - a. TK/Kinder 50%, 1st grade 48%, 2nd grade 41%, 3rd grade 37%, 4th grade 35%, and 5th grade 27%
 - b. Mrs. Hansen pointed out that the numbers are decreasing in the upper grades because students have more time throughout the school year to reclassify, and more students are being reclassified in the lower grades.
- 5. Importance of Attendance**
 - a. Mrs. Hansen shared a document on the importance of attendance and what parents can do to ensure their child arrives on time and attends school.
- 6. School Plan for Student Achievement - Goal 3**
 - a. Mrs. Hansen shared the PJUSD Goal and AES Goal with parents.

- b. AES goal - Students enrolled at AES since kindergarten will be reclassified by 5th grade.
- c. Reading and writing are two subject areas that are holding students from being reclassified.
- d. Mrs. Hansen stated that all grade levels have tier 2 intervention, focusing on reading comprehension during the day.

7. ELPAC Testing

- a. Mrs. Cano shared that ELPAC testing has started for 3rd - 5th grade, so they will have it completed before CAASPP testing. Mrs.
- b. Mrs. Cano shared that we would start testing in February in the past but moved it to March to provide students more time to practice and prepare for the test.

8. Summer School

- a. Mrs. Hansen shared summer school information and where the link was to sign-up or that a Chromebook was available and the office would help if they needed support with signing up their child.
- b. Mrs. Hansen also shared information about the after-school program and the enrollment form.

9. Public Comment/Evaluation of Meeting

- a. A parent asked if a student needed help in a specific area on the ELPAC. How does the teacher inform parents? What is being done to help that student in that area?
- b. Mrs. Hansen told the parents that when teachers meet with parents during the conference, they should explain the ELPAC results, how they are supporting the student during the school day, and provide resources to help their child.
- c. Mrs. Cano explained the steps for being reclassified, and she shared that SRI testing starts in first grade.
- d. A parent asked what time the bus was for summer school. Mrs. Hansen said there is bussing to school at noon. Parents need to pick up their child if a student stays after for the expanded learning program.
- e. Parents felt that they had a voice in the meeting.
